NOW, THEREFORE, the condition of this obligation is such, that if the principal shall promptly make payment to each and every Claimant, as hereinafter defined, for all labor, materials, supplies and rental of equipment reasonably required and used or consumed in the performance of the Contract, and of all such alterations and modifications of said Contract as may hereafter be made therein, in the manner and to the extent which said Contract provides for such alterations and modifications, during the original term of said Contract and any extensions thereof which may be granted by the Owner and agreed upon by the Principal, then this obligation shall be null and void; otherwise it shall be and remain in full force and effect.

The Surety expressly waives any right to receive notice of extensions of time, or alterations or modifications of the Contract, which are provided for and made pursuant to the terms of said Contract.

PROVIDED, HOWEVER, anything in said Contract to the contrary notwithstanding, this bond is executed upon and subject to the express conditions and limitations of State Finance and Procurement Article, Section 13-501, Annotated Code of Maryland (1985), as of the date of this Contract wherein it is set forth as follows:

"(c) Suits on Payment Bonds – Right to Institute – Every person who has furnished labor or material in the prosecution of the Work provided for in such Contract, in respect of which a payment bond is furnished under this section and who has not been paid in full thereof before the expiration of a period of ninety (90) days after the day on which the last of the labor was done or performed by him, or material was furnished or supplied by him for which such claim is made, shall have the right to sue on the payment bond for the amount, or the balance thereof, unpaid at the time of institution of such suit and to prosecute said action to final judgment and execution for sum or sums justly due him; provided, however, that any person having direct Contractual relationships with a Subcontractor of the Contractor, or with any Subcontractor of the Contractor but no Contractual relationship express or implied with the Contractor furnishing said payment bond, shall have a right of action upon the payment bond upon giving written notice to the Contractor within ninety (90) days from the date on which such

person did, or performed the last of the labor or furnished or supplied the last of the material for which such claim is made, stating with substantial accuracy the amount claimed and the name of the party to whom the material was furnished or supplied or for whom the labor was done or performed. Such notice shall be served by mailing the same by registered or certified mail, postage prepaid, in an envelope addressed to the Contractor at any place he maintains an office or conducts his business, or his residence.”

“(d) Same – Where and When Bought; Liability for Costs – Every suit instituted under this section shall be brought in the appropriate court in the political subdivision in which the Contract was to be performed and executed, or in the political subdivision where the Contractor has his principal place of business and not elsewhere, but no such suit shall be commenced after the term of one year after the date of final acceptance of the Work performed under the Contract. The obligee named in the bond or the trustee for any other security shall not be liable for the payment of any cost or expense of any such suit.”
