2. Purpose and Format of the Meeting
 - A. The purpose of the meeting is to introduce the project to the property owners and account holders, and to discuss any questions and comments.
 - B. The format of the meeting is a brief presentation followed by opening up the floor to discussion.

3. Project Information

A. Background

- The project will connect the new water main being constructed with State Highway Administration MD 237 Chancellors Run Road Widening Project to the existing water main located on Great Mills Road. The project is referenced in the Water and Sewer Facilities Plan for Pine Hill Run Sanitary District 8 and Piney Point Sanitary District 5.

B. Budget – The project is part of the FY2011 Capital Improvement budget.

C. Description

- The Project will provide system looping thereby improving system reliability, and maximizing efficiency of wells and storage. The project will include the installation of 12” water main, together with fire hydrants along Chancellors Run Road; two (2) new service connections will be required for this project.

D. Schedule

- Solicitation for bids is anticipated to be on or about October 2010 and the contract award will follow.
- The Notice to Proceed for construction will follow shortly after the contract award. The proposed work is anticipated to be completed on or about January 2011.
- Construction working hours are as specified by the contract documents and Maryland State Highway Administration permits. General work hours are 7:00am to 3:30pm.

- There will be two new service connections provided for this project. The project is part of the current 2011 Capital Improvement budget and fees will be required for new connections.

B. Interruptions of Service

- Service may be interrupted for short durations for the tie-in of the new water main and the individual connections at each meter vault; notice will be given for the interruptions.

C. Traffic Concerns

- Construction equipment and materials will be in the area; traffic control measures will be provided. Access to all properties will be provided at all times.
