2. Purpose and Format of the Meeting

- A. The purpose of the meeting is to introduce the project to the property owners and account holders and to discuss any questions and comments.

3. Project Information

A. Background

- The project was initiated as part of the Lexington Park Water Improvement Project that extended the water main from Great Mills High School to Hills Trailer Park. The water main was then extended further to Chesapeake Charter School. This phase will extend the water main from the Charter School to Pleasant Mill Drive at the entrance to Cecil's Mill Subdivision. Easements were provided for the Board of County Commissioners' property and the Jackie Dyson property.

B. Budget – The project is part of the prior years Capital Improvement budget.

C. Description

- The project will provide adequate fire flow protection, system looping and future requirements that are needed to improve system reliability and maximize use of supply and storage. The project will include the installation of a 12" water main, together with fire hydrants, along Great Mills Road; no new service connections required for this project.

D. Schedule

- The solicitation for bids is anticipated to be on or about September 2010 and the contract award will follow.
- The notice to proceed for construction will follow shortly after the contract award. The proposed work is anticipated to be completed on or about December 2010.
- Construction working hours will be as specified by the contract documents and Department of Public Works permits. General work hours are 7:00am to 3:30pm.

- There will be no new service connections provided for this project.

B. Interruptions of Service

- Service may be interrupted for short durations for the tie-in of the new water main; notice will be given for the interruptions.
