TEC Review/Concept Plan

TEC fees are determined by the County Comprehensive Water & Sewer Plan (CWSP) Service Categories

- No Public Water or Sewer \$ 60.00
- Public Water and/or Sewer \$ 120.00

Minor Subdivision*

- Public Water and Sewer[†] \$ 550.00 + \$250.00/Lot**
- Public Water or Sewer[†] \$ 400.00 + \$200.00/Lot**

Major Subdivision*

Up to a Maximum charge of \$20,000 per construction plan

- Public Water and Sewer[†] \$1,500.00 + \$250.00/Lot**
- Public Water or Sewer[†] \$1,125.00 + \$200.00/Lot**

Minor Site Plan*

- Public Water and Sewer[†] \$ 125.00 + \$100.00/EDU**
- Public Water or Sewer[†] \$ 90.00 + \$ 75.00/EDU**

Major Site Plan*

(This includes road only plans with water and/or sewer extensions)

Up to a Maximum charge of \$15,000 per construction plan
