

## SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM

**Purpose:** A Scholarship for the Children and Grandchildren of MetCom Employees was established in 2018.

**Eligibility:** Eligible applicants include high school seniors, high school graduates or current college students who have earned a minimum 2.5 cumulative high school or college Grade Point Average and plan to enroll full time in an accredited college or in an accredited vocational training program.



**Amounts:** The Scholarship consists of a total award of \$2,500, shared among up to five applicants, with a minimum of \$500 per applicant depending on the number of applicants.

**Source of Funding:** This Scholarship program is funded by the generous donations of a Mr. Keith Fairfax, a Metropolitan Commission Board Member. No customer/rate payer's monies are being utilized to establish or supplement the Scholarship. Employees also have the opportunity to personally contribute to the Scholarship fund through payroll deduction.

**Program Administration:** The program is independently administered through the Business, Education and Community Alliance (BECA). BECA is a local non-profit organization founded in 1989 jointly by the St. Mary's County Chamber of Commerce and Superintendent of Schools.

**Scholarship Committee:** A Scholarship Committee, which is comprised of 4-5 MetCom employees, was established to ensure that implementation is carried out in a fair and consistent manner, to facilitate communication with the donor, and to act as a liaison between the Commission and BECA.



First Time Recipient: On May 14, 2019 the Business, Education and Community Alliance (BECA) held their 2019 Scholarship Awards Ceremony at the Dr. James A. Forrest Career and Technology Center.
