

Notes:

- 1. Meter shall be from an approved manufacturer.
- 2. Meter connections shall be flanged.
- 3. Meter pit shall be sized to accomodate the meter with adequate room for maintenance.
- 4. Plastic meter box covers shall not be permissible.
- 5. All copper lines shall be type "K" (Federal Spec. WW-T-799).
- 6. Meter pit shall be constructed of concrete, ABS plastic or an approved equal.
- 7. Larger frame and lid meter box cover may be used with the approval of the Engineer.
- 8. Meter shall be placed as close as possible to the property line.
- 9. Meter shall be not be placed in areas subject to vehicular traffic without the approval of the Engineer.
- 10. Meter located within 3 feet of a driveway shall have the lid assembly encased and supported with concrete.
